Race regulation:
The event is based on the competition regime of the German Triathlon Association (Deutsche Triathlon Union, Sports Regulation, Organizer Regulation, Regulation for the German Triathlon Bundesliga, Antidoping Regulation, Marshall Regulation) as well as the Law and Process Regulation and the Disciplinary Regulation. By registering the athlete accepts these regulations and the legal and process regulation binding.

The courses:

[Challenge Half](#) 1.9 km swim / 90 km bike / 21 km run

(Time limit: Swim 70 min; after bike 5 h 20 min; Finish 7 h 55 min)

[Olympic Distance](#) 1.5 km swim / 40 km bike / 10 km run

(Time limit: Swim 55 min; after bike 2 h 55 min; Finish 4 h 05 min)

[Sprint Distance](#) 0.5 km Swim / 20 km bike / 5 km run

(Time limit: Swim 25 min; after bike 1 h 35 min; Finish 2 h 25 min)

+ relay for Challenge Half, Olympic Distance and Sprint Distance

Remark:

- The stated time limits are valid after race start. Athletes exceeding the limit must stop the race or will be disqualified.
- ON the whole bike course, the German Traffic Act ("Straßenverkehrsordnung") is valid.

Start Olympic Distance: 12:30 am, waves starting every 10 min.

Start Sprint Distance: 14:00 pm, waves starting every 10 min.

Included in your entry fee are following performances:

In comparison to the last year there are six price steps, according to the registration time.

The contract is generally closed for the standard price when registering online. Nevertheless, each participant reserves the right for the respective **early bird price** if **registering** in the above stated time frame and paying **until 7 days after** registration.

All fees include 19% VAT and the duty for the regional Baden-Württemberg Triathlon Association.

A late registration is possible during the distribution of race documents on Saturday before race day, in the case of free starting places. It will be charged a late registration fee of EUR 25,-.

Payment of the entry fee, licence fee (if necessary) or additional booked performances (e.g. Late Check-In Challenge Half), can effected by debit note (SEPA) or credit card.

All bank fees or credit card fees must be paid by the participant.

Entry limit:

The number of entries on the several distances is limited as follows:

License/One-day permit:

Athletes without a valid license of their national triathlon association must purchase a one-day permit for the Olympic Distance for EUR 20,- and for the Challenge Half for EUR 25,- at the pick-up of the race package.

Starters on the sprint Distance and relay starters do not need a license or permit. Athletes with valid license must show it personally with an official ID at the race package pick-up.

Time keeping:

The time keeping is done with the active transponder system of the Abavent GmbH from Kempten. The required chip is provided on loan. If the chip is not returned after the competition, the loss will be billed at € 30, - per chip.

Prize money and prizes in kind:

Prize money will be given only on the Challenge Half distance for single starters (1.9 / 90 / 21 km).

Prize money overall.

Men & Women – places 1 to 6:

On all other distances there will be given non-cash prizes.

Age groups and judgement:

M = male, W = female.

Age-class is counting.

Every age group with at least three participants will be judged.

Minimum age:

For all single distances and relays only athletes are admitted that are of full age according to German law (18 years old) the latest when picking up the race package at the race office (entry hall of the City Hall) and acknowledging the disclaimer. A club membership is not necessary.

For the Challenge Half, the Olympic Distance, the Sprint Distance and all relays athletes are admitted, which have completed the age of 18 on the competition day.

Relays:

A relay team must consist of a minimum of 2 athletes, i.e. there is also the possibility that one person accomplishes two parts for one team. In a relay team with only two athletes, the disciplines for one of the two may not lie successively.

Application:

Registration takes place via the online registration system of the company Abavent GmbH / PANI Solutions. When logging on, it is recommended to set up a personal user account. As a result, each user has the advantage of personal data like name, club, etc. to be adjusted later. A right to a starting place exists only after payment the receipt. If no deposit is received 7 days after registration, the application may be canceled. A start exchange is excluded.

Deregistration/withdrawal and partial refund of entry fee:

Only until May, 31st 2018, a deregistration/withdrawal is possible. By this time a partial refund of the entry fee will be made. After a deregistration the entry fee will be refunded after a deduction of EUR 50,-.

After this date no refunds will be made.

Deadline:

May, 31st 2018. Entry fees must be on the bank account on June, 5th 2018 the latest, otherwise there is no right on start.
